Dear Parents/Guardians of Delaware Valley High School Seniors:

Delaware Valley High School would like to announce some of the special events planned for our senior class! Barring any additional schedule changes, the last day of classes for seniors will be Monday, June 2nd. Graduation practices will be held Tuesday, June 3rd, Wednesday June 4th, and, if necessary, Thursday, June 5th. Graduation will be held Friday evening, June 6, 2025. Seniors are permitted and expected to leave campus after each graduation practice. The last day of school for students in grades 9-11 has been changed to Wednesday, June 4, 2025. Students will be dismissed at 11:15 a.m. on this day.

The prom is scheduled for Friday, May 16, 2025, at the Kalahari Resort and Convention Center from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Dinner will be served at 7:00 p.m. If the procuring of formal attire for the prom is a burden for any student, please contact the student's school counselor who will discreetly provide assistance. No student should be left out due to the expense of a tuxedo or gown. The prom is a Delaware Valley High School function, and all rules and regulations apply.

Graduation is scheduled for Friday, June 6, 2025, beginning at 7:00 p.m. in Warrior Stadium. Each graduate will be given a certain number of tickets. Each graduate will be given seven tickets for the ceremony and seating will be on a first-come - first serve basis. The stadium has roughly 3,000 seats. Everyone needs a ticket for admission to the graduation ceremony including infants, toddlers, and pre-school children. If it is raining on June 6th then graduation will be scheduled for 10:00 a.m. Saturday, June 7th. If it is still raining Saturday morning, then graduation will take place at 7:00 p.m. Saturday, June 7th. If the rain continues into Saturday evening, then the final adjustment will be Sunday, June 8th at 3:00 p.m. Graduation will be live streamed through Blue Ridge Cable. Changes will be communicated via the Delaware Valley telephone emergency notification system as well as the district website and social media accounts.

Cap and gown and graduation ticket distribution will take place after graduation practice. Seniors who owe books, equipment, or fees will not receive a cap and gown and will not receive tickets until those obligations are fulfilled.

Scholarship Night is scheduled for Wednesday, May 28, 2025, beginning at 6:00 p.m. in the auditorium. Graduates receiving local scholarships are invited along with their family, relatives, and friends. No tickets are necessary, and all guests are accommodated for the Scholarship Night. Formal attire is expected.

The Outstanding Student Recognition for Athletics is scheduled for Monday, June 2, 2025. There will be light refreshments beginning at 5:15 p.m. in the 11/12 cafeteria for the students and their coaches. The awards presentation begins at 6:00 p.m. in the auditorium; parents, family, and friends are invited to the awards presentation.
