Quarantine Academic Access Plan

Elementary Students

- The school can provide a Chromebook, if needed.
- Students will access Schoology daily for assignments to complete for each subject.
- Students will be able to access their classroom via a Zoom link in Schoology.
- Some special area subjects such as physical education are not conducive to Zoom so students will be provided additional time upon their return to complete any outstanding assignments.
- Students are responsible for reaching out to their teachers with questions and turning their work in to teachers in a timely fashion.

Secondary Students

- All secondary students were offered Chromebooks at the beginning of the school year. For those without one and in need, they can contact their school's main office.
- Students will access Schoology daily for assignments to complete for each class.
- Students will be able to access their classes via Zoom links in Schoology.
- Some special area/elective classes such as physical education are not conducive to Zoom so students will be provided additional time upon their return to get additional help and complete any outstanding assignments.
- Students are responsible for reaching out to their teachers with questions and turning their work in to teachers in a timely fashion.

Notes

- This temporary Zoom option is only for quarantined students (i.e. new COVID positive cases and close contacts).
- Zooming will only occur in classrooms where students are currently in quarantine.
- While this modified Zoom option won't be as interactive as being in the classroom, it will provide virtual access to live instruction.
- Students with IEPs/Chapter 15 agreements should contact their case manager through Schoology for assistance with modifications/accommodations as needed.
- Please contact your child's school if he or she is quarantined for a non-school case.
