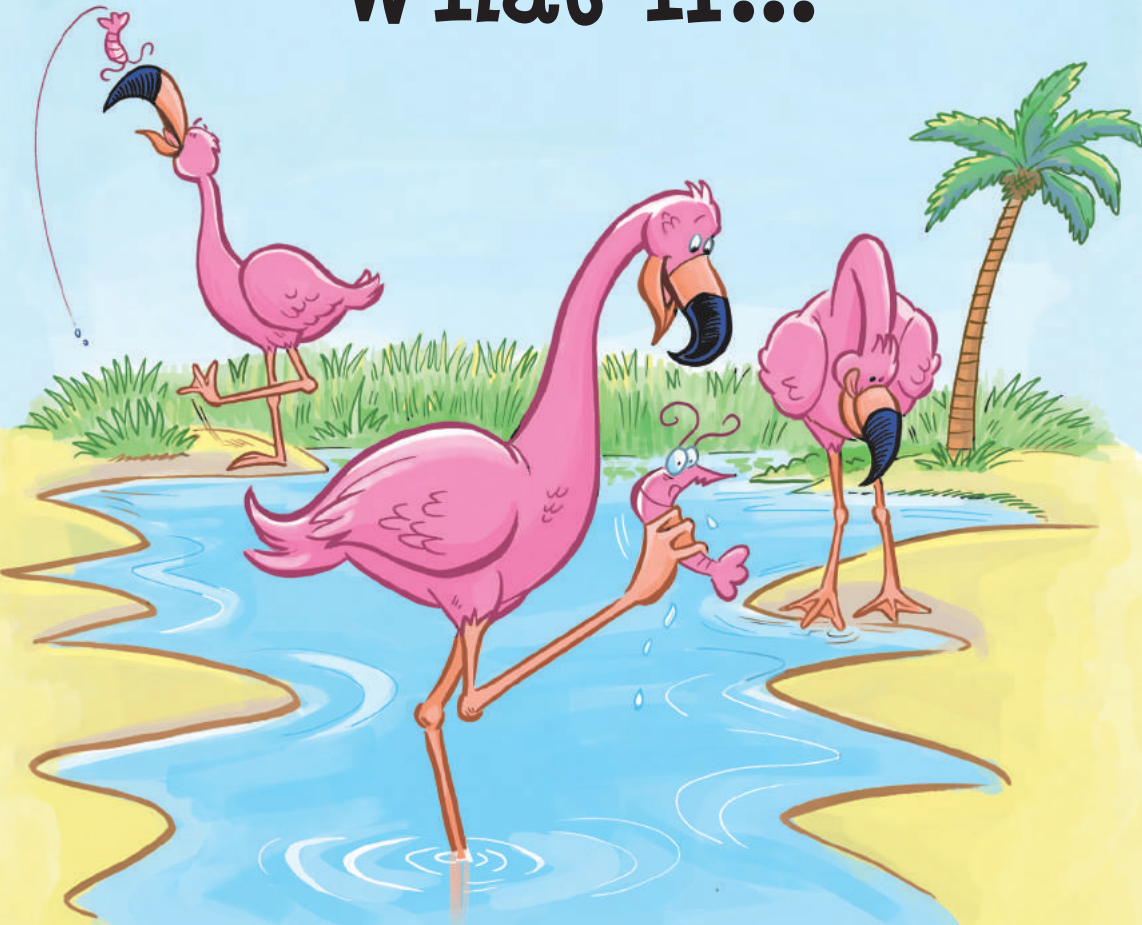

Every So Often A Zebra Has Spots is a must have in your child's book collection.

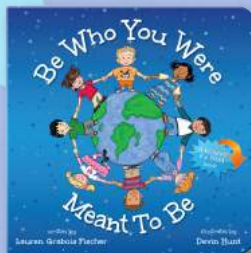
