LANGUAGE ARTS

Reading/Literature

- -Silent and oral reading
- -Reading comprehension
- -Vocabulary building

Vocabulary/Spelling

- -Weekly spelling lessons
- -Use vocabulary words in correct context
- -Use of the dictionaries, glossaries, reference materials, library

Grammar

- -Communication, focus on 7 parts of speech nouns, verbs, pronouns, adjectives, adverbs, prepositions and conjunctions,
- -Base words, word endings, suffixes, prefixes the sentence, capitalization, punctuation

Writing

- -Penmanship practice to improve legibility and neatness
- -Composition of letters, book reports, short stories

MATHEMATICS

- -Work with problem solving through word problems,
- -Add and subtract multi-digit numbers up to six digits.
- -Add and subtract dollars and cents.
- -Multiplication of multi-digit numbers, products up to six digits,
- -Division of multi-digit numbers, dividends to six digits, divisors to three digits,
- -Study of fractions, decimals, percents
- -Measure to the nearest inch, half inch, quarter inch and eighth inch

SCIENCE

- -Earth science topics including solar system, rotation and angulation of earth.
- -Stars, fossils, evaporation, precipitation, weather, pollution;
- -Biological science topics including human anatomy, function of body systems and organs, nutrition, plants and animals

SOCIAL STUDIES

History

-Study of Pennsylvania history, including European settlement, relationships of early settlers to Native American populations, role of colony in Revolutionary War

Civics

- -Discussion of current events.
- -Discussion of national holidays

Geography

- -Recognize geographical and agricultural regions of the United States,
- -Map skills, use maps to describe and learn about the physical and geographical features of the earth,
- -Natural resources of Pennsylvania

SAFETY EDUCATION AND FIRE SAFETY

- -Regular and continuous instruction in the dangers and prevention of fires,
- -Establish and practice an emergency exit plan from our home,
- -Practice of safety procedures keeping play situations safe

HEALTH

- -Increase knowledge of good nutrition and other areas affecting good health, dangers of alcohol and/or drug abuse,
- -Increase knowledge of human anatomy major systems circulatory, digestive, respiratory and nervous, understand and demonstrate good hygiene
