

# Tomorrow's Leaders Today (TLT) and Leadership U Application

**DEADLINE: FRIDAY, MAY 7, 2021 - 4:00PM** 

Leadership Lackawanna's seven-month Tomorrow's Leaders Today program develops the leadership, interpersonal and managerial skills of high school juniors and provides real-world experiences in the areas of philanthropy, non-profit organizations and community service. In addition to the skills learned and topics explored, the opportunities and challenges of north-eastern Pennsylvania are discussed as participants network with community leaders and other high school students.

Leadership Lackawanna and Penn State Scranton are proud to offer a new, collegiate-level initiative called Leadership U. Participants will gain leadership and community engagement skills in the areas of public speaking, S.T.E.A.M., historical awareness, financial literacy and career exploration. Leadership U will be held in-person, every Wednesday, June 30 through August 4, from 1:30-3:45pm. This Program accepts applications from juniors, with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher. If selected, the student must be a senior to participate. Upon successful completion, participants will receive three college credits to Penn State. The credits are for a general education, 100 level class and are transferable to most institutions.

#### **CRITERIA AND INSTRUCTIONS**

- The Tomorrow's Leaders Today (TLT) program <u>accepts applications from sophomores</u> and Leadership U <u>accepts applications from juniors</u> who attend high school in Lackawanna County or in the Lackawanna Trail or Western Wayne districts. Students should demonstrate leadership in both school and community activities, and express interest in increasing their awareness of northeastern Pennsylvania. If selected, the student must be a junior to participate in TLT and a senior to participate in Leadership U.
- A non-refundable \$20 processing fee (payable to Leadership Lackawanna) must accompany the application.
- **Download this application at www.LeadershipLackawanna.com.** Thoroughly complete every section. Limit your answers to the space provided. Do not leave sections incomplete. Quality and appearance are taken into consideration.
- Two reference forms must accompany the application: one school reference and one community reference. A reference from your parent/guardian will <u>not</u> be accepted. The reference may email the reference form directly to leadership@scrantonchamber.com. Additionally, the form may be submitted with the application. (Typed or hand-written permitted.)
- Leadership Lackawanna has a competitive selection process and not all applicants can be selected. Completion of the application does not ensure acceptance. The Selection Committee will review all applications based on leadership potential, interest or involvement in school and community activities and clarity and creativity in responding to application questions. Honors and awards are considered, but not key.
- If accepted into TLT, tuiton will be paid by the school district.
- TLT applicants will be notified in writing in early June of the Selection Committee's decision.
- If applying for Leadership U you must have a 3.0 GPA or higher.
- If accepted into Leadership U the \$400 tution is your responsibility. Partial Scholarship are available on a limited basis.
- Leadership U applicants will be notified in writing in late May of the Selection Committee's decision.
- Individuals who discontinue or who are dismissed from either program will not receive a refund.

#### RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT
