Early Childhood Education

Early Childhood Education is a college level program for High School students who want a career working with young children. The course is 3 periods per day for 3 full years. It enables students to be prepared to acquire a CDA and/or attain college credits. In the first year the H.S. students observe and assist at professional daycare Centers in our town. During the second year our students prepare lessons and teach a free preschool twice a week in the High School. The third year of the program allows the students to observe and teach in an elementary school, grades K-3.

During the normal High School schedule, second year students prepare and teach lessons to our preschool students.



Toddlers ages 3 and 4 are welcome to attend and gain one-on-one instruction and interaction

with the High School students and their DVHS teacher Mrs. Jill Farr. **The agenda for the program is to educate the child as a whole.** Of course the academic areas are addressed, but care is given to promote social and emotional well-being too. The toddlers enjoy a fun environment that is creative and stimulating.
