<p>1. Authority SC 502, 1901, 1906</p> <p>SC 1903</p> <p>Title 22 Sec. 4.41</p>	<p>It is the policy of the Board that the district may conduct a summer program of instruction for resident students of this district and other students the Board may admit.</p> <p>In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Employ certified teaching and administrative staff. 2. Provide necessary books, materials, supplies, and equipment. 3. Utilize schools or other facilities as required. 4. Provide necessary custodial services. <p>Planned instruction offered in tuition-based summer school may be designed as credit or noncredit offerings.</p>
<p>2. Guidelines</p>	<p>This program will be available on a tuition basis to all individuals on a first-come, first-served basis. Limitations on age groups or prerequisites will be listed in advertising for the program. If enrollment in a particular class does not reach levels necessary to support a class, the class may be cancelled.</p> <p>With regard to transportation, the Board does not accept responsibility for any student.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent or his/her designee shall be responsible for developing regulations for the tuition-based summer school program.</p> <p>Guidelines for the operation of tuition-based summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of tuition-based summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions.</p>
