## 210.2. SPECIFIC MEDICAL PROCEDURES

1. Purpose

This policy shall provide guidelines for when it is necessary for a student to have a specific medical procedure performed at school.

2. Authority

The district will not permit any specific medical procedure without the written permission of the doctor and parent/guardian. This includes, but is not limited to, medical procedures such as clean intermittent catheterization, ostomy care, respiratory care, and tube feeding. Non-emergency procedures that are not medically necessary during the school day will not be performed within the school buildings.

The district agrees to hold harmless and indemnify all district nurses and employees delegated to perform medical procedures against any and all claims, damages, expenses, attorneys' fees, suits, cause or causes of action in law or equity, or any case that may be brought against such employees in connection with such performance.

3. Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent or his/her designee shall develop procedures necessary to implement this policy.
