212. REPORTING STUDENT PROGRESS	
1. Purpose Pol. 216	The Board recognizes that communication between school and home is a vital component in the growth and education of each student. The Board acknowledges the school's responsibility to keep parents/guardians informed of student welfare and academic progress
2. Authority	<p>The Board directs that the district's instructional program shall include a system of measuring all students' academic progress.</p> <p>The Board directs the Superintendent to establish a system of reporting student progress that includes academic grade reports and parent/guardian conferences with teachers. Student progress is also available through the parent portal.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop procedures for reporting student progress to parents/guardians.</p> <p>All appropriate staff members, as part of their professional responsibility, shall comply with the systems established for measuring and reporting student progress.</p>
4. Guidelines	<p>Various methods of reporting appropriate to grade level and curriculum content shall be utilized.</p> <p>Both student and parent/guardian shall receive ample warning of a pending grade of failure, or one that would adversely affect the student's academic status.</p> <p>Scheduling of parent-teacher conferences should occur at times that ensure the greatest degree of participation by parents/guardians.</p> <p>Review and evaluation of methods of reporting student progress to parents/guardians shall be conducted on a periodic basis.</p> <p>Grade reports shall be issued at intervals of not less than quarterly.</p>
