	223. USE OF BICYCLES AND MOTOR VEHICLES
1. Purpose	The Board regards the use of bicycles and motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents/guardians and students.
2. Authority	The Board shall permit the use of bicycles by students in accordance with district rules, provided that students have been granted permission by the building principal and have obtained parental permission to ride a bicycle to school.
	The Board shall permit the use of motor vehicles by secondary students in accordance with district rules, provided that such students are licensed drivers and have followed established procedures, obtained the required permit, and paid the permit fee.
	The Board shall not be responsible for bicycles or motor vehicles that are lost, stolen, or damaged.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The building principal or designee shall develop rules and regulations for operating and parking of bicycles and motor vehicles, and shall disseminate those rules to affected students.
	The building principal or designee shall establish standards for granting permits, which contain the warning that infraction of rules may result in revocation of the permit.
4. Guidelines	The number of vehicles allowed on campus may be limited based on grade level with senior and junior students being given priority. The need for alternative transportation by the student due to activity or job commitments shall be given special consideration (only for seniors and juniors).
	Any student who violates this policy will be assessed a money fee. Repeated violations of this policy many result in the vehicle being towed from campus at the student's expense. The money from these parking fees shall be deposited into the district activity fund for parking lot improvements and associated parking costs.
