321. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES	
1. Authority	<p>The Board recognizes and encourages the right of its administrative, professional and classified employees, as citizens, to engage in political activity. However, district property and district time, paid for by the citizens, may not be used for political purposes when performing assigned duties.</p>
SC 510	<p>Employees shall not engage in political activities during assigned work hours.</p> <p>The following situations are exempt from the provisions of this policy:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Discussion and study of politics and political issues when appropriate to classroom studies, such as history, current events, and political science. 2. Conduct of student elections and connected campaigning. 3. Conduct of employee representative elections.
